Language Trip

A class of primary school students (grade 3 and 4) visit a place where they are able to put difficult words into context and consequently expand their vocabulary.

Location: A company or a place in the city

Time commitment: 2,5 hours



Digital skills

5th and 6th year primary school pupils follow lessons by (IT-)professionals and become familiar with 21st century skills. They learn the basis of programming, as well as learning to analyse, discover algorithms, and dissect problems.

Location: At school, during class

Time commitment: 2 lessons (1 hour)

Primary school students (5th and 6th grades) and vocational secondary school students (year 1 and 2) visit a company for an introduction to several professions.

Location: At the office

Time commitment: 2,5 hours

Vocational secondary school students get a realistic idea of the daily routine of running a business. Coaches from the business community guide the students through the assignments.

Location: At school, at an entrepreneur and at external location(s)

Time commitment: 2 contact moments

A training for VMBO 3 to learn essential skills in building contacts that can be used at networking events.

Location: At a company (or, by arrangement, at school)

Time commitment: 1 day



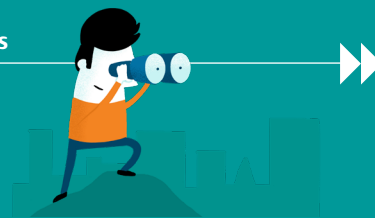
Job application training
